- Big pets leave big messes! You might want to get a bulldozer for backyard cleanups.





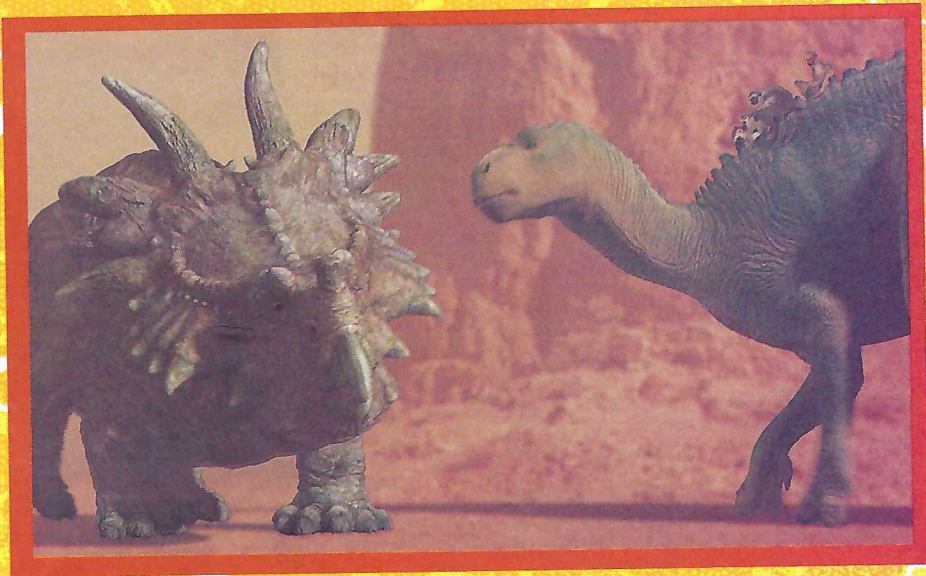
